EXECUTIVE BOARD

Executive Board Update April 17, 2024 meeting

Reports: Max Mock presented the February end-of-the-month financials in Katherine Haff's absence. Contributions at the end of February far exceeded expenses – good to see! The timing of the Stewardship Commission and Executive Board meetings and working out details with the accounting firm prevent us from being able to review the most recent month-end financials. The treasurer and Stewardship Commission are looking at ways to provide more current/up-to-date financial information to the Board. Dates for the 2024 Sing Me Home Festival concert series have been determined; dates and the final details will be announced after the contracts are signed with the various performers. The Nomination Committee held an initial organizational meeting on April 21 with hopes that the slate of candidates will be presented to the Executive Board in August.

Business items included: Approvals of the transfer of membership for Loyce Borgmann to the Middlebury Church of the Brethren, and Steve Mason and Marilyn Sexton Mason to the Goshen City Church of the Brethren. Approval of \$5,520 from the Capital Expenditures fund for a termite treatment project, and \$5,000 for repair and painting of the front entry and Port Cochere (portico), Peace Patch covered walkway, and the steeple. The 2nd Quarter Special Offering to Growing Hope Globally was approved; the special offering day will be June 16 and information will be available in the Narthex several weeks prior.

Discussion items: Gwen shared ideas for special summer fun worship plans. An outside worship service will be held each month of the summer. We'll meet for worship at the venue by the Memorial Garden at 6pm on Sunday, June 23. Sunday, July 21 will find us near the solar panels for worship at 9:30 a.m. with a Solar Panel Party afterwards (more details coming). Our annual Camp Mack worship service will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Sunday, August 25. Various intergenerational activities will be planned for each outdoor service.

Pastoral Search: The Search Committee submitted the Congregational Profile to the District Executive on April 16. The Committee welcomes the congregation to submit names of potential pastoral candidates to Lila Hammer or Jim Shively; those names will be forwarded to the DE. Questions and protocols are being determined in preparation for interviews when candidates are identified.
