# **EXECUTIVE BOARD**

The Executive Board welcomed 4 new members at the January 17 meeting: Board Chair Lila Hammer, Fellowship Commission Chair Wendy Metzger, and Nurture Commission Co-Chairs Mark and Anne Steury. Lila Hammer and Treasurer Katherine Haff led a board training session which included a review of the MCOB By-Laws, discussion of board and commission chairs responsibilities, review of the voucher and bill-paying procedures, and ideas for increased communication from the Board and Commission chairs to the congregation.

Business items included: election of Mel Sautter as Board Vice Chair; setting the Spring Council meeting for 1:15 on Sunday, March 17 (following a Fellowship Meal); moving \$10,000 from Estate Funds to the Immigrant Ministry Fund; naming the Manchester Science Olympiad as recipient of the Farringer estate tithe; and approving One Great Hour of Sharing as the first quarterly offering.

Pastoral Search: The Board discussed next steps in the pastoral search process. The Board requested a specially called meeting with Laura Stone, District Executive Minister, to review the responsibilities of the Board and the search committee in the process. The meeting will be held prior to the February Executive Board meeting (Feb. 21). The Board discussed methods for gathering input which is needed from the congregation for the search process. Decisions about the search committee and information gathering will be determined after the meeting with the DE.
